4. Logic and evidence

- a) Are there any logical fallacies or misleading conclusions? Explain.
- b) What kind of evidence would you need to verify the main claim?

5. Your evaluation

- a) Do you believe the main claim? Why or why not?
- b) How can you apply what you learned to evaluate real news online?
